Engel Cemetery

is located south of Pendleton, Warren Co., MO in a State Forest, it is fenced.

(Little Lost Creek State Forest, bordered by Rte.B. on the west and Rte. EE on the east. T46N * T47N, R3W & 4W, about 4 to 5 miles south of I-70 and the Montgomery County line)



Micheal Engel b. Jan 02 1808 Wuerttemberg, Germany d. Feb 03 1879 Warren Co., MO

Magdaline Marguerite Ott Engel b. Nov 12 1818 Adieshiem, Germany d. Nov 25 1901 (second wife of Micheal Engel, married @1845 in Germany)

Gottlieba Catherine Engel Kimmel b. Jun 30 1842 Wuerttenberg, Germany d. Feb 03 1878 Warren Co., MO (Dau. of Micheal Engel and Unknown. Married Jacob Henry Kimmel @ 1861 in St. Louis, MO.)

Rosa Kimmell d. Oct 17 1884 (believe she is the infant dau. of Jacob Henry Kimmel and his 2nd wife, Cecelia Thompson) (This grave is outside the fenced area of the other 3, but has a barbed wire fence around it.)

Notes: Micheal Engel came to America in 1847 with his 2nd wife and 5 children. They settled in Cambria Co., PA. After 8 years they came to St. Louis, and then to Warren Co., MO. They settled on 320 acres south of Pendelton, Warren Co., MO, where this cemetery is located. Micheal Engel first married Unknown and had 4 children: John Conrad Engel, George Johann Engel, Jacob F. Engel and Gottlieba Catherine Engel. His first wife died @1845, he married Marguerite Ott @1845 in Germany, they had 7 children: William Wilahelm Engel, Mathias Engel, Andrew D. Engel, Mary Dora Engel, Caroline Engel, Christina Engel and Wilhelmine Engel. Gottlieba Catherine Engel married Jacob Henry Kimmel @ 1861 in St. Louis, MO, he was a merchant in Pendelton. They had 5 children: Henry Kimmel, Emma Kimmel, Charles Kimmel, George Kimmel, and Lila Kimmel. After his wife's death, Jacob married Cecelia Thompson, Oct 07 1882, they had 2 children: Rosa Kimmel and Julius Kimmel.
