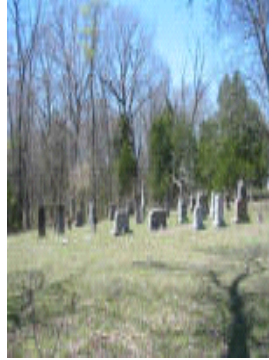


Hochfeld Evangelical Church/Cemetery

Directions: From Hwy 70, take Hwy. 47 south to Main Street/Booneslick. Turn right. at bottom of Main St., turn left on Hwy U. Go about 7 miles. Church/cemetery will be on your right.

It is a very well maintained small cemetery. About 85% of the tombstones in the cemetery have been transcribed. . There are a few that are unreadable or would require more time to try and transcribe. Quite a few are written in German.

CORVEY Carrie, Dec 23, 1885-Aug 26, 1943

DOTHAGE, William E., June 15, 1856-Jan 22, 1945

Louisa M. Aug 12, 1859-July 11, 1923

DOTHAGE, August H., Sept 1, 1852-Aug 31, 1923
Tombstone reads: The Lord is my Shepard I shall not want.

DOTHAGE, Amanda A., March 13, 1861-March 31, 1946
Tombstone reads: Rest in Peace

DOTHAGE, Alfred, Oct 29, 1880 -Oct 21, 1886
Tombstone reads: Son of August and Amanda DOTHAGE

DOTHAGE, Wilhelm E., Dec 12, 1876-March 22, 1877

HUMPHREYES, Laura Francis, Sept 2, 1858-March 23, 1885
Tombstone reads: Wife of A????? DOTHAGE

LICHTE, ??????, Nov 14, 1834-Dec 21, 1875
Herman, Jahr. 1823-Dec 13, 1875

These two are on the same stone. It is hard to read. The death year for Herman appears to read 1875, but the '5' could be another number

LICHTE, Ida C., Nov 6, 1875-April 22, 1924

This tombstone reads: Sister

It is next to Herman BACKS and is the same kind of stone that Herman BACKS has. Possibly his sister?

LUECKEMANN, Caroline,

Tombstone appears to read: Frau von Phillip Lueckemann, April 14, 1894. Im Alter von 65 Jahren.

LUECKEMANN, Philip, Oct 1, 1823-May 21, 1898

MCCANN, Rob't. This stone is weathered. The last name appears to read 'MCCANN', but could be McCALL or MCCAMM. The tombstone reads (what can be read): Co. H. 3rd, ???? Cav., did (died) Set (assume they meant Sept) 13, 1876. Around the engraved words is a shape something similar to a policemen's badge shape. The words are inside of the shape.

The POLSTONS are on the same stone. It reads: To the memory of our Father and Mother, ??????, died May 3, 1885, aged 73 years. His wife Lydia (nee POLSTON) died Aug 22, 1885, ages 79 years.

SCHALLOTE, Hanna, Sept 21, 1825-April 23, 1887. Tombstone appears to read: Fritz Meyer geb. Timmerberg
