

In 1850, R.T. (Rukehill Tyler) and W.G. (William) **HAMPTON**, ages 16 and 17, appear in Warren County in the household of George W. **BLEAR** and his wife Nancy, 38 and 39, with their three children (all under 10), and another woman, 19-year-old Susan S. WILLS/MILLS. Everyone in the household was born in Virginia.

Tyler (as he was known) is my husband's 4ggrandfather. This is the first record that I have found of him or W.G. In 1860, Tyler is living in Loutre Twp., Montgomery County, with his wife Elizabeth (QUICK), 3 children, and a man named James Stephenson. He died in Loutre Twp. in 1897.

In 1860, W.G. is also living in Loutre Twp., with James M. HAMPTON, 52, and Mary J., 28. James was born in Virginia, Mary in Missouri. W.G. did marry and had 5 children listed in his 1894 will. The Montgomery Co atlas states his birthplace as Pittsylvania Co., VA, and that he went to MO in 1833 (that's most likely his birth year). To date, Pittsylvania Co. has proved another dead end.

Does anyone recognize any of these people? I have a whole bunch of questions I am quickly going nowhere with:

Who are the Blears?
Are they related to the Hamptons?
Is Nancy possibly their mother, aunt, or sister?

Did the boys come with them to MO, or were they field hands or something along those lines?

When did W.G. and R.T. make the trip to MO?

Did they come straight from VA?

Where is James in 1850? Mary?

If Mary was born in MO in 1838 or so, where is James in 1840? I've been assuming that James is their father--could be actually be an uncle? Or even a brother or half-brother?

If anyone has any suggestions for further searching in Warren Co., I'd like to hear them. My Missouri research has all been in Montgomery.
